From the President's Desk

The Motorcycle Safety Foundation recently graduated its six millionth Rider Course student, a milestone reached through the ongoing efforts of nearly 10,000 Rider Coaches at more than 2,000 training sites worldwide. Our chapter has been involved with the MSF courses since 2004, proudly assisting 38 riders improve their skills through the MSF Scholarships that we have awarded over the last nine years!

2011 did not "officially" break the 2010 total miles for the chapter. When the VP had announced all his figures we were a bit short with 168,267 but that is still quite the number, and also without a few of the *high rollers* not sharing their mileage with us in time!

If you have not gotten your end '11/ beginning '12 mileage in, drop Kevin Martin an email or call so he can log you in to this year's "race for the mileage." For 2011 our top three mileage getters were Bob Laford, Maury Lizotte, and Ed Brouillet with 19,081, 17,005, and 13,469 miles respectively. And Phil Jordan's GL1200 passed the 100,000 mark!

In 2011 we had over 40 chapter events on our calendar, but the weather for the year was unpredictable and we did have some "rain outs" and ended up with 38 held events/rides/gatherings. Over the course of the year we had an average attendance of 15.73 per ride. The Christmas party and Americade tied for our most attended events with 30 members each. Our "lightest" attendance was seven for a ride in July.

- We were pleased to hear from our Texas connection that she would be home for a few days in October and may be interested in a ride. Actually we received specific orders to put together an impromptu ride while she was here.
- Just a few short days after the October snow storm (and a few

- It was 33 degrees when I left the garage for our November breakfast club meeting. We had three bikes and three cars arrive (10 people total). We went to The Crossroads Café (formerly Olsen's) in East Templeton.
- We had 15 people come out for the December Breakfast... and with Marcia's daughter Katie visiting from school in Las Vegas we figured the snow shower we experienced on the way to the Glen Café in Winchendon was an answer to her wish for snow for Christmas! - THE SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS WILL BE AWARDED ON MARCH 1, 2012

BEGINNER COURSE ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Submit application before due date of February 1, 2012.
- Members of the RK Chapter and their family members will be given first priority for the scholarship.
- Members of the fire service, their families, and applicants recommended by a Red Knights member will be second priority.
- 4) Applicant shall hold a valid Mass. Motorcycle License OR Learner's Permit
- 5) Applicant shall fill out a parental consent form if under the age of 18.
- 6) Awardees shall write a brief post course evaluation and send it to the RKMA2/ MSC committee within two-weeks of completing the rider education course.

EXPERIENCED COURSE ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Be a member of RK MASS-2
- Fill out application form and send it to a member of the RKMA2/MSC Scholarship committee before February 1, 2012.
- Awardees shall write a brief post course evaluation and send it to the RKMA2/ MSC committee within two-weeks of completing the rider education course.

Experienced Rider Course is awarded based on

- 1) How long the applicant has been a member of RKMA2
- 2) How long the applicant has been riding a motorcycle
 - *The beginner course scholarships are available to anyone. The Experienced Rider scholarships are available to members of the Chapter only.

This award will be granted based on the applicant's willingness and desire to take the course to better their riding skills and is on a voluntary basis. This award is not designed to be an indictment of a rider's skills or as a prerequisite to riding with the group.
